**Foundation Diploma in Art and Design-** 1 Year Course allowing entry to university. Requires minimum 50% in HSSC or O levels in 5 subjects A\*-C, IELTS overall 5.0 and no component less than 4.5, Art related portfolio

**Entry Requirements:**

- \*Minimum 50% marks in Bachelor of 1 or 2 year or minimum 50% marks in HSSC or A level in 3 subjects A\*-C
- \*Course Duration: 2 years
- \*Course Fee: £6100/year      \*Overall IELTS 6.0

**English as a Foreign Language:**

**General English:** Starts at every Monday, Duration up to 1 year,

Study options: 6 hours, 12 hours, 15 hours, 21 hours and 25 hours per week

Course Fee £ 70 for 6hrs/wk, £125 for 12hrs/wk, £150 for 15hrs/wk, £185 for 21hrs/wk, £210 for 25hrs/wk

**AS-Level/A-Levels (September & January Session):**

Applied Business, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Economics, Environmental Studies, Further math, Geography, Geology, Global Development, Government and Politics, Graphics, History, ICT, Law, Maths, Physics, Music, Physics, Psychology, Science in Society, Sociology, French, German (IB certificate), Spanish (IB Certificate)

**Entry Requirements:**

- \*O Levels in 5 subjects having grades A\*-C      \* Course Fee: £ 5, 750/year
- \*Course Duration: September session is 2 years; January Session is 18 months
- \*For September session: IELTS overall 5; for January session IELTS overall 5.5

**A deposit of 50% is required to pay for all courses except for English where entire balance is required and for extended Diploma in Aerospace Engineering 70% Advance deposit is required**

**Refund Policy:** Tuition fees are refunded in full with the deduction of £ 20- £90 in case of visa rejection. £25 is required to pay for new CAS.

**Admission application checklist for Diploma, Foundation & Top-Up Programs**

- HSSC and SSC degrees (not provisional certificate) should be attested by IBBC and Foreign Affair Office
- 2 years Bachelor degree should be attested by HEC,
- IELTS , CV (optional)
- Statement of Purpose (not less than 300 words). It should highlight previous qualification, work experience, proposed course and future plan after completing proposed course
- 2 Passport Size Photos, Valid passport + CNIC, 1 recommendation letter
- Financial support: If bank statement is on parent's name then b-form with English translation and birth certificate with English translation is required.

**Admission application checklist for Master Programs**

- HSSC and SSC degrees (not provisional certificate) should be attested by IBBC and Foreign Affair Office
- 4 years Bachelor degree and Master degree should be attested by HEC
- IELTS, CV, Experience letter (if any), 2 Recommendation Letters. Both letters should not be of same wording
- Statement of Purpose (not less than 300 words). It should highlight previous qualification, work experience, proposed course and future plan after completing proposed course
- 2 Passport Size Photos + Valid passport + CNIC
- Financial support: If bank statement is on parent's name then b-form with English translation and birth certificate with English translation is required.
