Admission application checklist for Master Programs

- IELTS, CV, Experience letter (if any)
- Statement of Purpose (not less than 300 words). It should highlight previous qualification, work experience, proposed course and future plan after completing proposed course
- 2 Recommendation Letters. Both letters should not be of same wording
- 2 Passport Size Photos
- Valid passport + CNIC
- Financial support: If bank statement is on parent's name then b-form with English translation and birth certificate with English translation is required.
