Foundation in Business, Computer Science, Economics, Engineering, Law, Mathematics, Politics, Psychology, Sports Sciences and Science

**Entry Requirements for Foundation programme:**

- \*Minimum 50% in each subject in HSSC or 5 subjects of O level
- \*5.5 overall with no component less than 5.5
- \*Course fee for Engineering, Sports Science, Physics and Geography: £ 11, 500; Business Studies, Economics, Law and Mathematics: £ 9500 Computer Science: £11, 000
- \*Duration 2 semesters (Business, Economics duration is 1 semester)
- \*£2000 advance deposit required, remaining tuition at enrolment

**First Year Degree (Undergraduate Pathway) September Session:**

Computer Science, Economics (offered in January also), Engineering, Genetics, Mathematics, Media Studies, Politics and International relations, Psychology, Sports Sciences and Science

**Entry Requirements for Undergraduate pathway:**

- \*Minimum 50% in each subject in HSSC or 5 subjects of O level
- \*6.0 overall with no component less than 5.5 \*Course fee range from £10, 100 to £13, 000

**Admission application checklist for Bachelor Programs**

- IELTS , CV (optional), 1 recommendation letter
- Statement of Purpose (not less than 300 words). It should highlight previous qualification, work experience, proposed course and future plan after completing proposed course
- 2 Passport Size Photos, Valid passport + CNIC
- Financial support: If bank statement is on parent's name then b-form with English translation and birth certificate with English translation is required.

**Admission application checklist for Master Programs**

- HSSC and SSC degrees (not provisional certificate) should be attested by IBBC and Foreign Affair Office
- 4 years Bachelor degree and Master degree should be attested by HEC
- IELTS, CV, Experience letter (if any), 2 Passport Size Photos, Valid passport + CNIC
- Statement of Purpose (not less than 300 words). It should highlight previous qualification, work experience, proposed course and future plan after completing proposed course
- 2 Recommendation Letters. Both letters should not be of same wording
- Financial support: If bank statement is on parent's name then b-form with English translation and birth certificate with English translation is required.
